

Mapping Guidelines - Appendix 2

Mapping Rejection Slip (non-MSB)

The map which accompanied is not acceptable for the reason(s) indicated below.

Signature of Mapping Officer:

- The map is a **copy** and not an **original** Land Registry 'Title Plan', 'Special Registration map' or 'Official Map Search'. **(see Appendices 1 & 8(a))**
- The map is a **copy** and not an **original** OSi 'Land Registry Compliant Map'. **(see Appendices 1 & 8(b))**
- The map cannot be accurately related to OSi topographic detail on the ITM coordinate Registry map. **(see Rule 146(4) of LR Rules 2012)**
- Boundaries are not clearly and unambiguously defined. **(Rule 53 of LR Rules 2012)**
- The map is plotted at 1:5,000 or 1:10,000 scale. **(see note on Appendix 1)**
- The map does not comply with the Land Registry's current requirements for Development Schemes. **(see Appendix 3)**
- The map is not a copy of the scheme map bearing a current Land Registry approval stamp. **(see Appendix 3)**
- The map does not comply with the Land Registry's current requirements for Computer Generated (Hard Copy) Maps. **(see Appendices 1 & 4)**
- The map does not comply with the Land Registry's current requirements for lodging boundary geometry in a CAD file **(see Appendices 7(a) & 7(d))**
- The map is not true to scale/No map scale quoted
- The map is unsuitable due to the use of masking/correction fluid.
- The map is not drawn on stable drawing paper.
- Other.....
